## Royal Holloway Workshop with Fidelio Trio

Students from St. Joseph's, St. Bernard's, and Upton Court Grammar schools were fortunate enough to attend workshops in January and March led by the world-renowned Fidelio Trio - a classical piano trio lineup, hence consisting of the violin, the cello, and the piano. In the first workshop, the formidable playing by the three virtuosos took the students on a journey through time, featuring musical excerpts from composers such as Haydn and Ravel, through to the contemporary sounds of Philip Glass. Throughout, the trio demonstrated compositional techniques, and discussed how this had an impact on the sound and feel of the music we as the listener receive.

The second workshop then saw the students take some of their own compositional ideas in to be played by these accomplished professionals - a fantastic opportunity for all of our students involved!
